## *Note Changes in Conference Program*

- **Factors that influence managing nitrogen from manure** (Tom Morris)  
Learn the basics about managing nitrogen supplied by manure and how that relates to the real world based on hundreds of trials conducted in Iowa.
- **Managing forms, application timing and rates of nitrogen fertilizer for corn** (Peter Kyveryga)  
Learn more about what influences optimal management based on actual trials conducted in Iowa over the last six years.
- **Develop your own nitrogen management strategy** (Tracy Blackmer)  
Learn how to interpret the data and formulate a general nitrogen management strategy using all of the information that has been collected.
